



Resource Guide

Vermont's State House is one of the most open and accessible in the nation. Visitors are encouraged to watch debate on the House or Senate floor or to attend committee meetings. Information on particular bills is available from your local Legislator or the Legislative Council. Another good source of information is the Legislature's home page on the web, which has a calendar and bill tracking component. It's a good idea to check with the Sergeant-At-Arms' office before traveling to Montpelier because the scheduling of events can change on short

notice. The Sergeant-At-Arms' office can also help you navigate the State House, contact a Legislator, become a legislative page, arrange a group tour or answer just about any question you may have. The Secretary of State's office produces several valuable publications including the Vermont Legislative Directory and State Manual, and directories of Legislators and lobbyists, which are available at many local libraries.
